- License costs \$8.00 for spayed/neutered animals, \$12.00 for unspayed/unneutered Animals

## **RULES REGARDING DOGS**

- All dogs are to be behind a fence or on a chain/leash when outside. Failure to abide will result in an animal at large ticket. (This includes letting your dog outside to go to the bathroom)
- The keeping of more than three (3) dogs or cats over six (6) months old, outside in the yard, is hereby declared to be keeping or operating a kennel. Kennel Permit Fee is \$100.00 Annually.
- All animals kept outside for any amount of time must have access to shelter, food, and water.
- If your animal is at large, it will be impounded. You will be issued an animal at large citation and be charged pound fees. These fees vary depending on if the dog is tagged, spayed/neutered, and how many times it has been picked up.
- If your animal is ever deemed vicious, you must purchase an annual \$1000.00 Permit, a \$100,000.00 insurance policy, and abide by the city codes for housing such an animal.
